



500V N-Channel MOSFET




Figure 7. Breakdown Voltage Variation
vs Temperature




Figure 8. On-Resistance Variation
vs Temperature




Figure 9-2. Maximum Safe Operating Area
for JFAM20N60C




Figure 10. Maximum Drain Current








Figure 11-2. Transient Thermal Response Curve for JFAM20N50E






Gate Charge Test Circuit & Waveform





Resistive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms
